The Cuba-Caribbean Entrepreneurs' Forum is coming up in July**

The Cuban Chamber of Commerce is inviting Jamaican entrepreneurs to the Cuba-Caribbean Entrepreneurs' Forum scheduled for July 15-17, 2015.

The forum will take place in the city of Santiago de Cuba, that country's 2nd largest city and capital of the province of the same name. As the crow flies, Santiago de Cuba is less than 160 miles away from Kingston!

The forum has been organized as part of the city's 500th anniversary activities, and will bring together Cuban companies engaged in agriculture, food & beverage, pharmaceuticals, biotechnology, informatics, tourism and construction – among others. According to the organizers, incoming firms from the Caribbean area will be able schedule B2B meetings with potential Cuban buyers, suppliers or prospective joint venture partners – if they register early - by June 15 - and clearly indicate their areas of interest.
